



RECOMMENDATIONS FOR THE THAI MINISTRY OF EDUCATION

- I**ntegrating mother tongue based education into national education policies, in the areas of curriculum, teacher development and assessment;
- D**evolving mother tongue based education programmes for ethnic groups in the northern highland border regions based on the learning first programme;
- E**xpanding the programme approved to other schools in the Deep South, where adapted curricula, learning materials and proven approaches to teacher development are ready to be scaled up;
- A**dopting the programme’s “Use for Ethnic Children” materials for migrant children from neighbouring countries studying in formal and non-formal settings in Thailand;
- S**etting up a system to recruit, train and deploy teachers from specific young age groups to serve in frontier areas, to support mother tongue programmes and improve teacher retention in remote areas.
