# 1. International Relations

Exchanges and **interactions occur across state borders**. This may be caused by states or other actors. that is not a state that results in cooperation or conflict between countries in the world

**(1) Formal or informal relations by the State.** or by a legitimate representative of the state, such as a summit conference, diplomatic action, statement of protest submitting a protest to the United Nations Or it could be an informal act such as terrorism, espionage an attack on one country by another country's media which is not acting on behalf of the state, etc.

# 1. International Relations

## (2) Relations in the nature of cooperative or conflicting relations

between countries that arise. If there is no cooperation, there will be conflict. Conflict relations such as war, meddling, sabotage, expansion of imperialism, annexation of another country's territory. Cooperation is to strengthen diplomatic relations, partnership, economic assistance, exchange of technology and culture, etc. However, various relationships can be of mixed nature, for example, sometimes violent, sometimes not severe, sometimes it's official, sometimes semi-formal, or sometimes cooperate in one matter but conflict in another, etc.
