

2) Law The Constitution of the Kingdom of Thailand, 2017, section 52, stipulates that the state must protect and maintain which the monarchy, independence, sovereignty, territorial integrity and the area in which Thailand has sovereign rights, dignity and national interests state security and public order For the purpose of this, the State shall provide effective military, diplomatic and intelligence services. Military power to be used for the benefit of the country's development.

The National Security Council Act of 2016, Section 13, provides for a policy and national plan on national security to be the main national policy and plan that is a framework or direction for the operation Prevention, warning, remediation or suppression of threats and maintain national security
